# Keynote Presenters:



## **Jason and Crystalina Evert**

Jason Evert earned a master's degree in theology, and undergraduate degrees in counseling and theology, with a minor in philosophy at Franciscan University of Steubenville.

He is the author of more than ten books, including *If You Really Loved Me*, *How to Find Your Soulmate Without Losing Your soul*, and *Theology of the Body for Teens*, which challenge young people to be pure.

After giving chastity presentations solo for three years, Jason teamed up with his wife Crystalina. They now speak internationally to over 100,000 teens each year in Catholic, Christian, and public junior and senior high schools, as well as universities.

Both Jason and Crystalina are full-time apologists with Catholic Answers, the nation's largest lay-run apostolate for apologetics and evangelization. After a year of speaking as an engaged couple, Jason and Crystalina married in 2003, and continue to share their inspirational testimonies with teens as well as parents.

## **Patrick Coffin**

Patrick Coffin is a dynamic speaker, emcee, and host of the top-rated national radio show, *Catholic Answers LIVE*. He has degrees in theology and philosophy from McGill University in Montreal and Franciscan University of Steubenville. A former stage actor, Patrick has appeared on the FOX Channel, Comedy Central, and EWTN. As a writer, his work has appeared in *Inside the Vatican*, *The National Catholic Register*, *The Toronto Star*, *St. Austin Review*, *New Oxford Review* and others. His first book is titled "Sex Au Naturel: What It Is and Why It's Good For Your Marriage."
